
LewisGale Pulaski focuses on four key performance indicators that are critical for ensuring its successful joint replacement program:

- **Documented Pain Reassessment**—ensures that patients are at a tolerable pain level to encourage early mobility.
- Vascular Assessment—ensures that proper blood flow to the operative extremity is adequate to decrease the risk of post operative complications.
- Physical Therapy Evaluation and Treatment— early ambulation and movement after joint replacement decreases risk factors, improves outcomes and decreases levels of pain.
- Surgical Site Infection Prevention results in improved patient outcomes, patient satisfaction and reduced readmission rates.

LewisGale Pulaski offers a complete array of Outpatient Physical Rehabilitation services including Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy and Wound Care. The Therapy staff at LewisGale Pulaski has a combined total of over 100 years of rehabilitation experience. In addition, we offer the following services:

A Certified Lymphedema Therapist -Lymphedema is characterized by an excessive accumulation of protein-rich fluid in the superficial tissues. The earlier lymphedema is recognized and diagnosed, the easier it is to successfully treat it. LewisGale is the only provider of this service in Pulaski County.

Vital Stimulation Certification -Vital Stimulation is a specialized form of neuromuscular electrical stimulation that re-trains the pharyngeal muscles in the throat, essentially re-educating the functional muscle use patterns necessary to initiate or re-establish swallowing.
